



Florida College NorCal Camp Basic Camp Rules and Regulations

Please review the rules and regulations info with your camper before camp. We will go over these again on Sunday, check in evening as well. Dress code is part of these rules but a reminder that shorts must go to the knee even for the boys.

DRESS CODE:

- All shorts **MUST** be to the knee or lower.
 - Shirts can have no inappropriate pictures or sayings.
 - Straps must be at least 2 fingers wide. No cut-off shirts.
 - Boys tank tops cannot be loose with large armhole cutouts.
 - Tight clothing not permitted.
 - Campers need to be adequately covered to and from the showers.
 - Flip flops may only be worn when heading to the shower.
 - Waterslide apparel must still follow dress code rules. Board shorts and rash guard shirts have worked very well for this activity.
- NO WHITE clothing please

ELECTRONIC DEVICES:

- Campers are not allowed any electronic devices (including cell phones, mp3 players, etc.)
- Cameras can be brought to camp but NO cameras are to be used inside camper cabins or the bathrooms at any time.

CAMPER MEDICATION:

All camper medications must be checked-in with the camp doctor/nurse during camper Check-in and disbursed only by the doctor/nurse during the week

CAMP BOUNDARIES:

Campers must always remain within camp boundaries and are not permitted to leave the campgrounds for any reason during the week. Boundaries will be explained at camp.

Basic Camp Rules and Regulations cont'd

CURFEW:

- Jr campers will be sent to their cabins at 9pm – 9:30pm.
- Sr campers will be sent to their cabins at 11pm.

Whatever time you and your co-counselor decide to make your cabin actually go to bed is up to you. That being said, at least **1 counselor must be awake as long as your campers are allowed to be up.

PRANK PROTOCOL:

Pranks are allowed for senior campers only. All pranks must be cleared through the Directors. Process for approval is that the prank must be written and signed by those who are planning the prank and at least one cabin counselor. Written requests will be reviewed by directors and must gain unanimous approval.

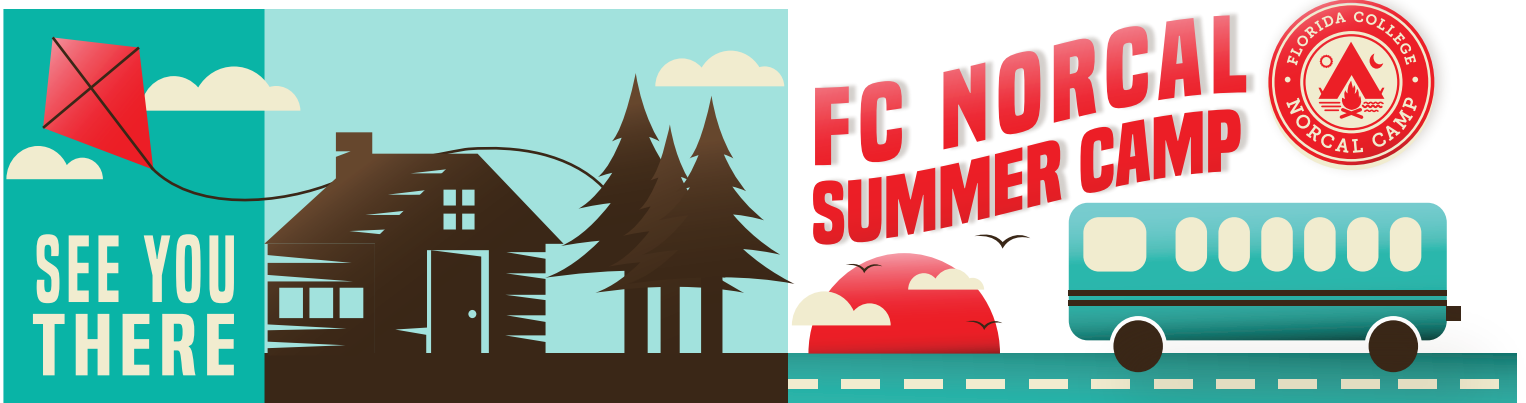

CABINS:

Campers should only be in their cabin during cabin devo time and bedtime unless authorized by their counselor, they must take a buddy from their cabin to go directly to and from the cabin.

CONDUCT:

Campers and staff are expected to show good conduct throughout the week; respecting one another, showing good sportsmanship, and edifying each other in action and in speech
